French Immersion programs are designed to provide non-francophone children with a high degree of proficiency in the French language. While any exposure to a second language is beneficial, French Immersion broadens and deepens that exposure. St. Edward CES offers an Early French Immersion program. The September 2024 online application process for French Immersion will be open as of Thursday, November 30th, 2023 for St. Edward CES.

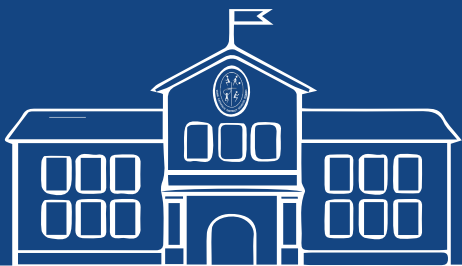

### Transportation will be provided to French Immersion Students living within the St. Edward CES French Immersion Boundary.



- Students in grades 1 to grades 3, residing 1.2 km beyond the school and within the FI boundary will receive transportation.
- Students in grades 4 to grades 8, who live beyond 1.6 km and live within the French Immersion transportation boundary will receive transportation.
